Dear Friends,

On behalf of the Cardinal Ritter Prep Board of Directors, I want to thank you, our donors, friends and benefactors, for your continued support and dedication to help us in our mission to provide a quality college-prep education and leadership training to our future community leaders. You responded to our need for increased financial support, and we exceeded our goal for fiscal year 2007. However, we face great challenges in the future and your continued support is essential to our success.

I want to provide you with some brief highlights of our recent success and the challenges we will face next year.

- This year, every Cardinal Ritter Prep graduate was accepted to at least one college or university, and our graduates garnered nearly \$2 million in scholarship support.
- Due to the generosity of donors, we were able to keep our tuition increase at only 3.5 percent. If we can continue to generate significant contributions, we should be able to maintain our policy of modest tuition increases.
- Even though our tuition is the lowest of any private school in the area, half of our students still require financial assistance.
- More than half of our families who apply for financial aid have an annual income of less than \$30,000. Thanks to the continuing contributions from the community, we are able to provide financial aid for these students.
- With the help of a very generous donor, we were able to hire an outstanding associate principal who will work with our faculty to improve our already strong curriculum.
- We have also hired a learning consultant to ensure the success of those students who might not otherwise meet the rigors of a college prep curriculum.

Your continued support and dedication to Cardinal Ritter Prep are extremely important. Our excellent and dedicated faculty, staff, board and leadership group are committed to our vision. Ours is a labor of love. Thanks again for all of your help.

The mission of the Intern Leadership Program (ILP) is to provide incentives for talented African-American youth to live, work and provide leadership in the St. Louis region, for civic and economic life, after college.

The ILP, which was funded by a generous grant from the Danforth Foundation, gives African-American youth opportunities beyond college graduation, to encourage leadership in the St. Louis community and to develop youth as highly productive, responsible citizens.

Cardinal Ritter Prep juniors and seniors in the ILP can receive leadership scholarships and summer internships with local major employers. ILP is a six-year program, with students trained in professional development and placed in internships throughout college. Upon college graduation, participants are in an excellent position to earn a job with the company for which they have interned through the program. The first phase of ILP students will graduate from college in 2007.
