A message from the President of the Board


Dear Friends,

Last year was a bittersweet year at Cardinal Ritter College Prep. Principal Carmele Hall retired after 25 years at CRCP and we will miss her very much.

In honor of Mrs. Hall's years of service and sacrifice, the school community organized a surprise retirement party. More than 400 people were involved in the celebration, including several Board and community members who were responsible for our amazing capital campaign that allowed us to build our new facility in Grand Center.

It was a wonderful opportunity to reflect, especially as we enter our 30th year of existence, on all the dedicated people and organizations in the St. Louis community who have made Cardinal Ritter College Prep the success story it is.

Last year, as in years past, every member of our graduating class was accepted to at least one college or university. The 94 members of the Class of 2009 garnered more than \$4 million in total scholarship offers. Two students from the Class of 2009, Darnell Cage and Glenda Jeffries, were awarded the Gates Millennium Scholarship, the most prestigious minority scholarship in the United States.

Our student athletes had one of the best years in our 30-year history. Our young ladies' basketball team won the state championship for the first time ever. The girls track team made it to the State Finals and the boys football team played for the State Final at the Edward Jones Dome—their best finish.

# Intern Leadership Program

Preparing students for the business world

The mission of the Intern Leadership Program (ILP) is to provide incentives for talented African-American youth to choose to live in, work in and provide leadership in the St. Louis region for civic and economic life after college graduation.

The ILP, which was funded by a generous grant from the Danforth Foundation, gives African-American youth opportunities beyond college graduation, to encourage leadership in the St. Louis community and to develop youth as highly productive, responsible citizens.

Cardinal Ritter Prep juniors and seniors in the ILP can receive leadership scholarships and summer internships with local major employers. ILP is a six-year program, with students trained in professional development and placed in internships throughout college. Upon college graduation, participants are in an excellent position to earn a job with the company for which he or she has interned through the program.
